**SW Mikro, SW 85, FT 50, FT 65** (racing on the small track)  
Regulations: **Estonian Championship** for SW Mikro, SW 85, SW 250, SW 500, SW 500 Kv  
**Estonian Cup** for SW 125 hobi, FT 50, FT 65, FT 85, FT Open, FT Quad, FT Kv

## 6. RIDERS AND MOTORCYCLES

All riders must hold a valid license to take part. Participants are obliged to present a valid national or international license issued by the federation of the rider's origin.

Riders that don't have a valid season license can obtain a one-time starting permit at the registration by presenting a valid ID and by paying the sum affirmed by the federation (10€ for FT 50, FT 65, SW Mikro, 25€ for all others).

**Ignition cut-out switch is compulsory for all motorcycles.**

## 7. PRE-REGISTRATION

Pre-registration on page <http://www.msport.ee/events/speedway-emv-ii-etapp-2016/> is open until 28th of June 2016. Pre-registration is **compulsory**, riders will not be allowed to race otherwise.

FT Open, FT 85, FT 65 and FT 50 consist maximum of 18 riders, all others maximum of 16 riders.

In case of not enough riders in a class (6 riders per class), the participation of the class will be decided after the end of pre-registration. The decision will be sent to the riders concerned by e-mail, and will be announced on the event's [Facebook page](#).

Participation fee: SW Mikro, SW 85, FT 50, FT 65, FT 85 – **20 €**; SW 125 hobi, SW 250, SW 500, SW 500 Kv, FT Open, FT Quad, FT Kv – **30 €**, will be collected at the venue.

The timetable may vary depending on the number of participants. Final timetable will be announced after the end of the pre-registration.

Every rider has 2 minutes of practice, 4 riders are allowed on track at the same time (6 riders at the same time in classes FT Open, FT 85, FT 65 and FT 50).

Practice and heat order will be announced at the venue.

## 9. RACE FORMAT

Races will be held according to pre-composed tables. The riders' positions in the table are determined by a ballot. This is conducted on a live-video by the Jury of the race after the end of the pre-registration. Link and exact time of the ballot will be announced on the event's official page at

**Speedway Mikro, Speedway 85, SW 125 hobi, SW 250, Speedway 500, Speedway 500 Kv**

Races will be held according to table, that is composed so every rider could compete with every other rider and start from every starting gate. All heats will be run with a maximum of 4 riders over 4 laps.

Riders will be awarded points in each heat according to their finishing position as follows: 1st – 3 points, 2nd – 2 points, 3rd – 1 point, 4th – 0 points. Eight top-scoring riders from classification will qualify for the semi-finals. First two riders of the both semi-final will meet in the final where positions 1 to 4 of the meeting are determined. All other positions are determined by points collected. Starting positions for the final and semi-finals are chosen by the riders. If less than 12 riders are registered semi-finals will not be held and 4 best placed riders of the classification will meet in the final. If less than 6 riders are registered, the final and semi-finals will not be held and riders' positions are determined by classification points.

**Flat track 50, Flat track 65, Flat track 85, Flat track Open**

All heats will be run with a maximum of 6 riders, every rider will ride at least 4 classification heats. Riders will be awarded points in each heat according to their finishing position as follows: 1st – 5 points, 2nd – 4 points, 3rd – 3 points and so on. Six top-scoring riders from classification will qualify for the final. Starting positions for the final are chosen by the riders. Positions 1 to 6 are determined in the final, all others are determined by points collected. If less than 8 riders are registered, the final will not be held and riders' positions are determined by points collected.

**Flat track Quad, Flat track Külgvanker**

Races will be held according to a table, that is composed so every rider could compete with every other rider and start from every starting gate. All heats will be run with a maximum of 4 riders, every rider will ride 4 classification heats. Riders will be awarded points in each heat according to their finishing position as follows: 1st – 3 points, 2nd – 2 points, 3rd – 1 point, 4th – 0 points. Two top-scoring riders from classification will qualify directly for the final. Riders on positions 3 to 6 will qualify for B-final. Two top-scoring riders from the B-final will also race in the final. Points are not awarded in the B-final. The starting positions of the final and the B-final will be chosen by the riders according to their' positions. If less than 10 riders are registered B-final will not be held and 4 best placed riders of the classification will meet in the final. If less than 6 riders are registered, the final and B-final will not be held and riders' positions are determined by classification points.

**10. PROTESTS**

All protests must be in writing accompanied by the fee (50€, engine capacity measurement protest 200€) and submitted to the Secretary.
